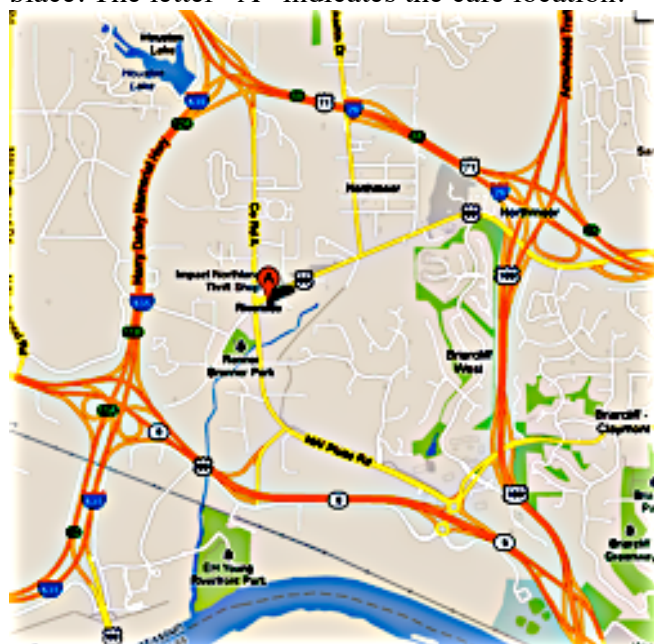
## December HARC Dinner Meeting
